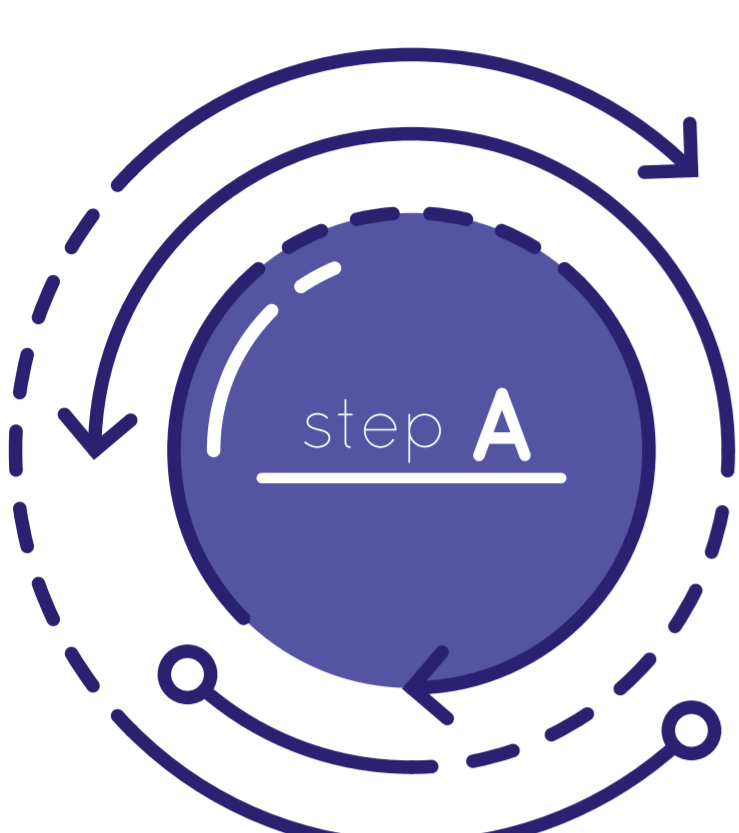

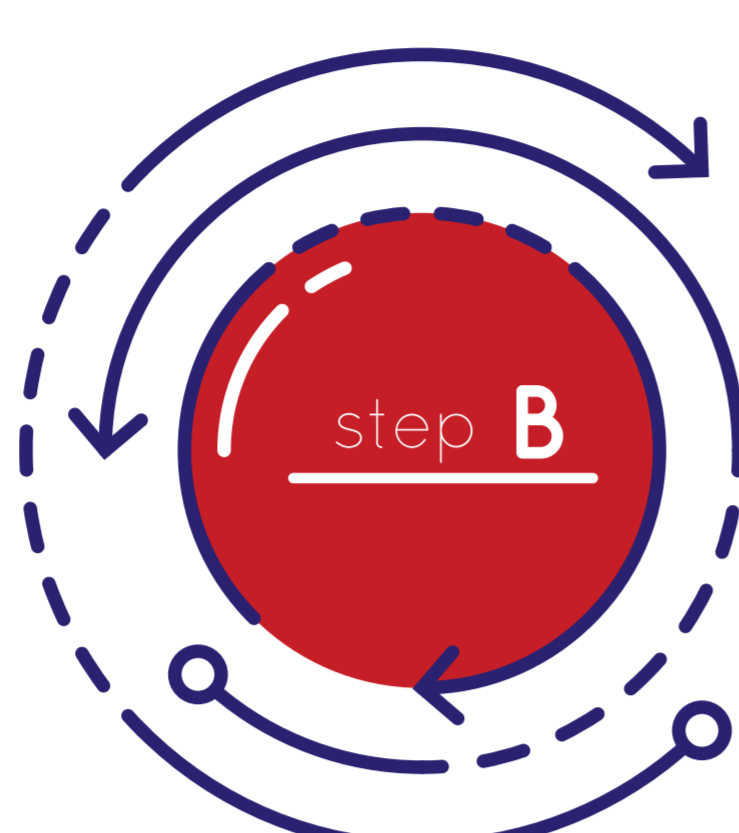

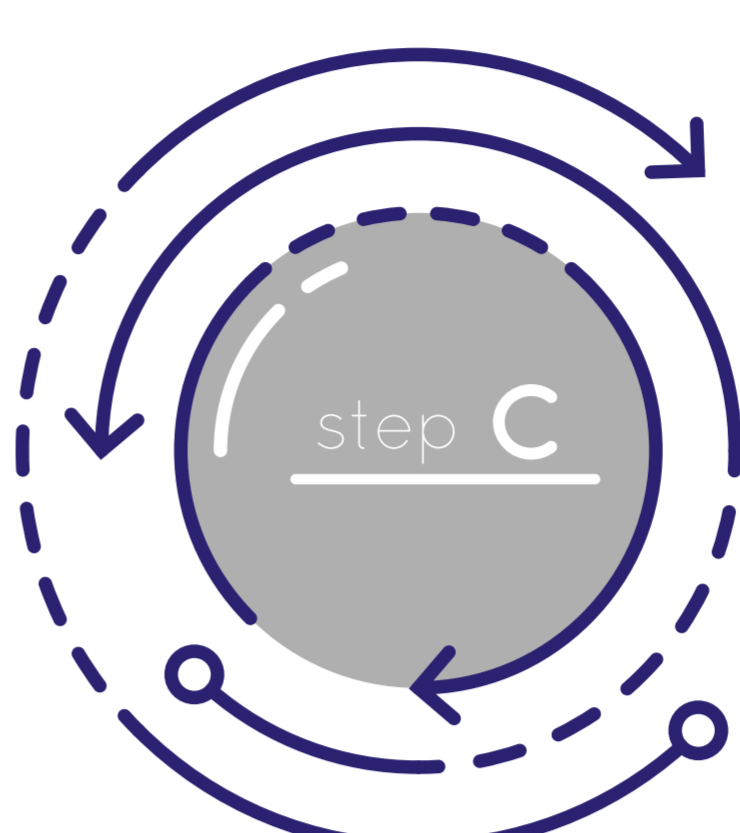

**Q: WHO IS A POLICY HOLDER?**  
A: A person whose name an insurance policy is registered in. This person is allowed to make changes to the policy

**Q: WHAT IS A PayAT NUMBER**  
A: Enables clients to make payments conveniently at retail stores, without visiting the branch

Hakhensa kuva mi take xiboho xova mamera ya Lebowa Funerals

**Q: WHAT IS A LAPSED POLICY**  
A: When the policy has exceeded 2 months and 7 days, meaning the policy is no longer active

**Q: WHAT IS A STOP ORDER?**  
A: Agreement between a client and their bank to instruct them to make future dated repeat payments on their behalf. Reference for payments should be your Policy

**Q: WHAT TO DO WHEN A LOVED ONE'S PASSES AWAY**  
A: If death occurs at home due to illness, medical personnel are required to issue a notice of death (BI 1663). If death occurs at a hospital the medical personnel will issue the notice of death

Contact can then be made to Lebowa Funerals to conduct a removal of the deceased. **We have a 24hour service line.**

What documents do I need when making arrangements?  

- Policy booklet/card
- Certified ID copy deceased
- Certified ID copy of the claimant
- Death certificate
- BI 1663
- 3 months bank statement (Compulsory)
